- Exhibits in this Department must have been grown by the exhibitor within the County, District or Community represented by the exhibitor, except classes for arrangements. Florist and nurseries may exhibit plants, plant materials and flowers which they currently sell but not necessarily grow.
- Only persons licensed to sell nursery stock may sell plant materials which have been incorporated in displays.
- EXHIBITS MUST BE ADEQUATELY AND CORRECTLY LABELED**
- In the fresh-cut flower classes, three stems with blooms must be displayed in each container,
- Shasta District Fair will furnish vases for the fresh-cut flowers, only.
- Entries open to non-commercial flower growers, except Div. 52.
- BOOTH:** Fresh plant material should predominate.
- No limit of entries per class except Division 32,38,51,52,& 53**
- If flowers deteriorate, replace on Friday Between 8 AM & 10 AM
- A vase is a container that is taller than it is wide.
- Arrangements not to exceed 24 inches in width or depth.

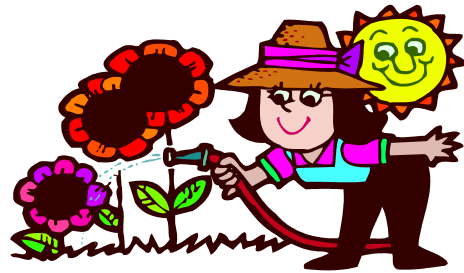

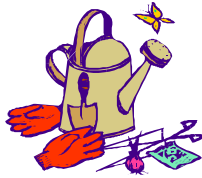
