Guidelines for Web design contest

1. Local and State rules govern this competition.
2. Only websites constructed by and for Shasta County residents or businesses are eligible.
3. Entries must be prepared by the Exhibitor.
4. Entries must be functional and ready to be judged between May 15th and June 14th.
5. Entry must include an 8 1/2" x 11" framed picture/copy of the home page. To be delivered on Sun. June 13th between 8 AM-6PM.
6. **All entries must include the website address on the entry form.**
7. Junior exhibitors are individuals ages 5-17.
8. Microsoft Internet Explorer and Netscape are the browsers of choice.
9. All entries must have been made, collected, grown, or prepared within 1 year of opening date of the fair unless otherwise noted.

Definitions:

- Personal** - This refers to personal entries that include individuals, couples, friends, or families.
- Business** - Any business site constructed for the consideration of the company's products and services.
- Community Group, Institutional, Government** - Any local nonprofit, educational institution, or other local government agency or institution.
- School/Classroom** - Any local public or private schools and classrooms qualify for this category.

Judging Criteria

Layout: points will be given for design layout and organization of media elements.

Functionality: All navigation links will be checked.

Technology: Use of multimedia, applets (JAVA, Javascript, etc.) and interactive players will be considered.

Interactive design: Use of multimedia elements and interaction to communicate and tell a story.
