

# OPEN HORSE SHOW

## Please refer to the General Livestock Rules

All Entry Forms Must be Accompanied by an Exhibitor Liability Waiver

### HALTER HORSE & HORSE SHOW RULES and GUIDELINES

Carefully read all General Local Rules, General Livestock Rules and the State Rules as some pertain to Horse Show Exhibitors and Entries.

#### **All State and Local Rules Apply**

**VETERINARY FEES:** A Veterinary fee of \$5.00 per horse will be charged. Refer to Horse Drugging Regulations, Subchapter 6, Chapter 2, Title 3 of the California Administrative Code. There will be NO drug fee charged on horses entered in the team penning in the Horse Show Department.

**EQUINE HEALTH REGULATIONS:** Nonsteroidal anti-inflammatory drugs are restricted to therapeutic usage as prescribed or administered by a licensed veterinarian, and test-sample levels detected must be in compliance with plasma levels associated with limited dosing. Additionally the detections of both phenylbutazone and flunixin (Banamine) in either a blood or urine sample is a violation of California rules.

**SHOW ROUTINES:** The routine for all Horse Show Classes will be set up by the Horse Show Judges and/or Manager.

**HORSES IN BARN AREA:** Horses will not be permitted in any other area of the Fairgrounds other than the Arena area. Any person violating this rule will be disqualified and premiums forfeited.

**HORSE STALLS: No Horse Stalls are available.**

Both light horse halter & performance shows are PAC approved and CHSA sanctioned.

#### Light Horse Division Rules and Guidelines: All State & Local Rules apply

1. ORIGINAL registration certificates naming the exhibitor as the owner OR (2) a copy of a notarized lease purchase contract AND a Photostatted copy of the registration certificate will be accepted for horses entered in the Senior Light Horse Divisions and Horse Show Department ONLY. However, if the Fair receives any complaint or challenge concerning the registration of any animal, the Fair may request an original registration and may disqualify the entry if it cannot be produced.
2. Photostatted copies are not acceptable for any other purpose in any other Department or Division.
3. In accordance with State Rules, junior exhibitors (under 18 years of age) will not be allowed to enter stallions in any Department or class.
4. Geldings may be used in entries of "Get of Sire" and "Produce of Dam" and must be entered as individuals only if classes are provided. If classes are not provided, geldings not entered as individuals may be used in "Get of Sire" and "Produce of Dam" but must be identified on entry form. An official document of the Breed Association must be presented showing that the gelding is the "Get" or "Produce" of the sire dam as entered.
5. Foals under 12 months of age and still owned by the owner/breeder can be exhibited when accompanied by the Mare's registration certificate and a copy of the breeder's certificate. If a foal one year of age is sold, a registration

certificate issued by the breed association must be presented by the owner.

6. **POST ENTRIES: Post Entries will be accepted with a late fee of \$25.00 per entry in addition to the regular entry fee.** Exhibitors may not enter the same horse in more than one breed division. Please see state rules.
7. To ensure adequate competition, divisions and classes may be combined or added at the discretion of the judge and/or Show management. Including but not limited to breed divisions or age classes.

### PERFORMANCE SHOW

#### Open Horse Show Guidelines and Rules:

1. Unless other rules are specified, rules and definitions for conducting each class as contained in the Rule Book of the USA Equestrian will apply to this Horse Show, provided they do not conflict with any of the rules and regulations prescribed by the Divisions of Fairs and Expositions of the California Department of Food and Agriculture.
2. Original registration certificates naming the exhibitor as the owner OR a copy of the notarized lease purchase contract AND a Photostatted copy of the registration certificate will be accepted for horses entered in the Senior Light Horse Division and Horse Show Department ONLY. Photostatted copies are not acceptable for any other purpose in any other Department or Division.
3. **Not more than one ownership on each entry form.**
4. Three entries by two or more exhibitors constitute a minimum Horse Show Class. Where entries are less than for a minimum class at the closing date of entry, the class shall be canceled. Canceled entries may be transferred without penalty into other classes of the same division. Should entries fall below the minimum after closing date of entry, a class may be continued with premiums at the discretion of the management.
5. Horses or ponies may be entered in as many classes as they are eligible except that horses or ponies entered in "local" classes can show in the same "extended" classes. (A pony is 14-2 hands & under.) The exhibitor (owner) is still limited to two (2) cash awards. See State Rules.
6. Junior exhibitors (under 18 years of age) will not be allowed to show stallions. Junior Exhibitors are allowed to enter Open Division.
7. **For Junior Horse Show - the age of an individual on January 1 shall be maintained throughout the entire calendar year and must be on the entry form. Age and Birth date MUST be included on ALL entry forms. See State Rules.**
8. Junior Exhibitors in any Horse Events or Shows must wear properly strapped headgear in mounted or horse-drawn vehicle competition. Headgear must be approved by American Society for Testing and Materials/Safety Equipment Institute.
9. Warm-ups will be allowed in the arena for a period of 1 hour prior to the beginning of the Show.
10. Fair Management will not retain prize money won in this department longer than twenty-one (21) days after close of the horse show.
11. **POST ENTRIES: No Post Entries will be accepted.** Management reserves the right to limit entries at

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Management's discretion.
