- **All lambs are required to have a valid Scrapies tag in their ear.**

### Market Lamb Grades

- **Market Ready:** USDA Prime or Choice in quality grade with 12<sup>th</sup> rib back fat range .16-.35, average or greater conformation, and cutability.
- **Not Market Ready:** Good or lower quality grade with 12<sup>th</sup> rib back Fat range <.16 or >.35; under finished lambs grading USDA good or lower, below-average conformation or cutability.



These Market Grades will be further broken down at the discretion of the judge and fair management.

**Exhibitors do not need to pre-enter to be in showmanship. Exhibitors wishing to participate in showmanship will be given age/color coded cards at weigh-in. The judge will select who shall participate in showmanship. All exhibitors will be given a fair evaluation.**

### GUIDELINES and RULES:

1. All State and Local Rules apply and will be strictly enforced.
2. Age in showmanship classes will be as of Midnight, December 31, 2009
3. Only animals owned, groomed, fitted and shown by the Exhibitor in Junior Department Livestock Divisions or required to be shown in the senior class under the provisions of State Rules are eligible.
4. **NOTE:** All Exhibitors are required to wear the official show uniform of the organization they represent.
5. All 4-H, FFA, and Independent members are to be in full organization uniform during all Showmanship classes. Any person not in full uniform will be excused from the show ring.
6. Only the winner of the FFA Showmanship, 4-H Sr. Showmanship, and Independent Sr. Showmanship are eligible for Round Robin Contest.
7. The 4-H and the FFA Round Robin winners are eligible for 2010 California State Fair Best of Show Competition.
8. Classes may be combined at the discretion of Fair Management if entry numbers are insufficient for adequate competition.
9. Novice FFA Exhibitors must be freshman or sophomore and never to have shown an animal before. 1<sup>st</sup> place award & ribbons to 8<sup>th</sup> place only.
10. 4-H Beginning Showmanship must be 9 or 10 years of age. 1<sup>st</sup> place award & ribbons to 8<sup>th</sup> place only.
11. 4-H Junior Showmanship ages 11 through 13 years. 1<sup>st</sup> place award & ribbons to 8<sup>th</sup> place only.

### Breeding Sheep Guidelines and Rules:

1. All State and Local Rules apply and will be strictly enforced.
2. Each Exhibitor is limited to two breeds and 14 animals in Registered Sheep.
3. Flock numbers shall be used to identify all entries. Registration numbers may not be used as flock numbers.
4. Flock numbers and breeder's initials, name or association prefix shall be on commercially used tags attached to the ear or tattooed in the ear of yearlings and lambs bred by the exhibitor.
5. Lambs must show lambs teeth.
6. Rams/Bucks older than 6 months require a negative Brucella Ovis test within 30 days of entry into California.

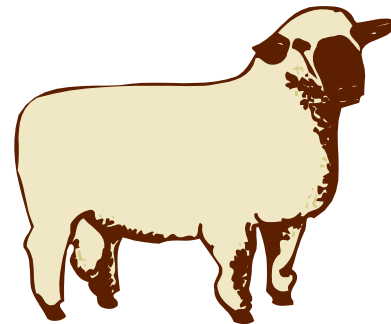
