4-H Horse Show Guidelines and Rules:

- Exhibitors proof of ownership in the form of a Bill of Sale or statement that the horse is the offspring of a mare belonging to the exhibitor OR - a leased horse as per the conditions listed in the State Rules Horse Show Rules. Confirming Affidavit must be on file at the 4-H office. The entry will not be accepted if the Bill of Sale is not presented at time of entry.
- Veterinary Fees: A veterinary fee of \$5.00 per horse will be charged (Refer to State Rules).
- 4-H entries will be limited to enrolled Horse Project Members of Shasta County 4-H Clubs and surrounding counties and their enrolled project horse or horses. Entry form must list horse's name, be signed by the horse project leader and the member's parent or guardian
- Age of an exhibitor will be based as of December 31st 2010.**
Ages for Classes are:

Beginning	9 -- 10
Junior	11 -- 13
Senior	14 -- Plus
- Horse project members may be allowed to enter the Senior/Junior combined Open Horse.
- Complete 4-H uniform (White pants and Long Sleeved White Shirt) and Western-type boots will be required in all 4-H Classes.
- 4-H members must have a release, emergency treatment sheet and equipment check sheet filed with their leader. Leader's signature on the entry form attests to this.
- Junior Exhibitors in Junior Horse Events or Shows must wear properly strapped headgear in all competitions.** Headgear must be approved by American Society for Testing and Materials/Safety Equipment Institute.
- USA Equestrian (equestrian.org) approved bits must be used in all Equitation, Horsemanship, trail, and pleasure classes. Choice of bits or hackamores will be left up to the Exhibitor in the gymkhana classes only. However, all horses must be under control at all times or they will be excused from their Divisions.
- Exhibitors are expected to be ready one class in advance. A warning call will be given 5 minutes following the preparation call. If Exhibitors do not answer roll following the warning call, they will be excused from the class.
- Warm-ups will be allowed in the arena for a period of 1-hour prior to the beginning of the show.
- Horse Show Exhibitors are to stay within their age category, except Novice Showmanship and Junior Showmanship classes may advance to Senior

Showmanship.

- Age classes may be combined at the discretion of Management if there are less than 3 entries in the class. Showmanship classes will not be combined.
- NOTE TO JUDGES:** Conformation of horses is not to count; rather the result the youngster is able to achieve. Use of fancy tack will not count extra. No tiedowns or other such devices will be allowed; EXCEPT IN GYMKHANA EVENTS. Showmanship will be scored according to the 4-H scorecard.
